Safe System of Work (SSOW):

- Arrive at weighbridge.
 - All external operatives must have completed the induction before they can gain access to the site.
 - Induction QRs code are attached to the rear of this document.
- Inform weighbridge operative of your waste type.
- The weighbridge operative will instruct you of what door to tip at (A-E).
- The weighbridge operative will then radio the site banksman's to ensure the site is clear for the driver to proceed.
- When ready the driver will be asked by the weigh bridge operative to proceed to the rear of the site where they will be acknowledged by a Re-Gen Waste banksman.
- The banksman will confirm the door letter they have been allocated and direct the vehicle into the door.
- Vehicle to reverse safely in and stop the vehicle as close to the shutter as possible, exit the vehicle and open doors taking care to not cross the red line. Vehicle to reverse back until you feel the stop blocks and begin to tip. Do not get out and watch. Do not cross the red line to check. When tipped, drive forward to close your doors. You must wait for the crane room operative to open the shutters to leave.
- When exiting the tipping door, the banksman will assist the driver and direct them to the exit lane.
- The driver will be required to stop at the weighbridge and sign the relevant paperwork before leaving site.
- Drivers to ensure speed limits are followed at all times and they remain watchful of other moving plant on site.


Open doors

red line




Reverse back.
